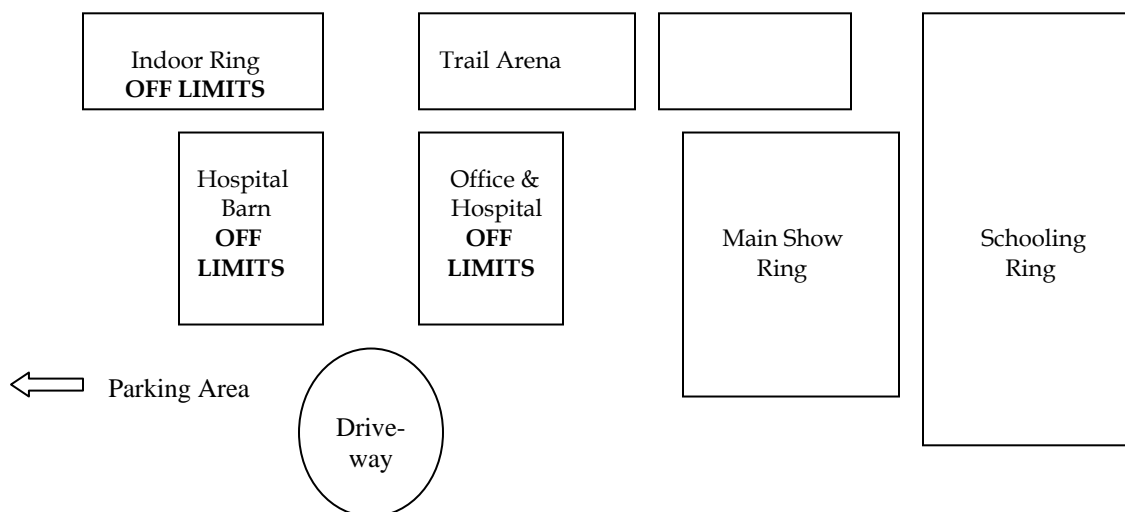

Rules and Regulations

1. Show management reserves the right to split, combine, or cancel classes.
2. Lamé horses will be removed from the classes at the judge's discretion.
3. All riders must sign the release from before competing. A parent or guardian must also sign for minors.
4. Parents or guardians must accompany all minors at the show.
5. ASTM/SEI approved safety helmet with a properly fitting chinstrap are required when mounted.
6. Show attire is encouraged, but not required.
7. A current Coggins certificate and signed release form are required with entries.
8. No tie downs, draw reins, or other schooling devices are to be used in the show ring.
9. Horses that are known to kick must wear a red ribbon in their tail for the safety of other exhibitors.
10. Schooling is allowed only in designated areas.
11. Keep the grounds clean. You will be expected to clean up after yourself and your horse, and remove any mess or waste that you and your horse leave. All exhibitors will be held responsible for any damages caused to the SEVS property.
12. Entrance to the hospital barn and buildings is strictly prohibited. Please respect ring designations, and only park your trailer in designated areas.
13. No dogs.
14. No stalls will be available.
15. Water spicket is available at the back end of the hospital barn. Please walk around to the barn, not through the barn.
16. Riders should only enter the walk/trot division for ages 11-18 if he/she is inexperienced at the canter. If the rider has experience cantering, then he/she must enter into either the intermediate or senior divisions, depending upon the rider's age.



***Please pay attention to designated riding areas around the property and respect management's decision to keep certain areas off limits**

Class Listing

Each class will run in order of age division (leadline, novice, intermediate, senior, and walk/trot (ages 11-18)), with the exception of trail, which will run in a separate ring throughout the day. The show will begin at 9am.

All classes are offered in one of 5 divisions. Riders must compete in their appropriate age and ability division.

- *Leadline*, ages 7 and under. All leadline classes designated with "a"
- *Novice*, ages 8-10 (walk/trot). All novice classes designated with "b"
- *Intermediate*, ages 11-14 (walk/trot/canter). All intermediate classes designated with "c"
- *Senior*, ages 15-18(walk/trot/canter). All senior classes designated with "d"
- *Walk/Trot*, ages 11-18 (for junior riders that are not comfortable at this time cantering their horses). All walk/trot classes will be designated with "e"

1b, 1c, 1d, 1e. Showmanship. Halter class. *Please note that there is no leadline showmanship class.

2a, 2b, 2c, 2d, 2e. Equitation on the flat. To be judged on the rider's position and abilities.

3a, 3b, 3c, 3d, 3e. Pleasure on the flat. To be judged on how well the horse responds and behaves.

4a, 4b, 4c, 4d, 4e. Horsemanship. Riders will show on the flat, and then individually will have to answer a question related to horses from the judge.

5b, 5c, 5d, 5e. Command. A "simon says" flat class to test how well the rider can control their horse.

*Please note that there is no leadline command class.

6a, 6b, 6c, 6d, 6e. Trail. An individual course incorporating obstacles that may be found on trails.

Entry Fee: \$7 per class, or \$35 per division. We will accept cash or check. Entry fees must be paid prior to showing.

Awards: 6 ribbons awarded in each class. A championship and reserve championship will be awarded in each division based on points accumulated throughout the classes.

Release Form

This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition [Saratoga Equine Fall Horse Show] to the following:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, handler, lunger, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death ("Harm").

I AGREE to release the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to my horse, or me including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to my horse, or me and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse at the Competition. I have read the rules about protective equipment, and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Federation strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries.

If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf.

I AGREE that the "Competition" as used above includes all of the officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and affiliated organizations.

I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in this competition.
